On 04-28-15 at 2338 hours I, Deputy J. Zarletti #239, was conducting patrol when I observed a black Ford, bearing WA registration 824WSH, traveling southbound on STH 32 at CTH E. I observed the Ford's driver's side headlamp to be defective. I observed the Ford continue southbound and it appeared as if it was checking taverns in the area. The operator of the Ford indicated turns, using a directional, into the Somers House Tavern and the Upper Deck Tavern. The operator never made turns into the taverns and deactivated the directional shortly after passing the taverns. The Ford then turned into the Northside Superette (1810 – Sheridan Rd.) which was closed at the time. Based on observing the defective headlamp and the suspicious operation of the vehicle, along with pulling into the lot of a closed business, I conducted a traffic stop on the

Gregory advised that he believed his insurance information was in the glove box. I had Gregory check in the glove box for the documents. While Gregory was checking the glove box, I observed several loose rounds of ammunition. The rounds appeared to be 9mm caliber based on previous training and experience. I asked Gregory if he possessed any weapons in the vehicle. Gregory initially denied having a weapon in the vehicle. When I advised Gregory of my observation of the ammunition, Gregory changed the information he provided. Gregory advised that he possessed a High Point 9mm handgun in the vehicle. Gregory advised that he had placed the weapon between the center console and the driver's seat prior to allowing Obadiah to operate the vehicle and had not moved it after Obadiah had taken control of the vehicle.

Gregory was not able to locate the insurance information in the glove box. Gregory advised that he believed the documents to possibly be in the center console area. I instructed Gregory not to reach for the documents due to the reported area of the handgun being in close proximity to the center console area. I asked
