SUMMARY OF CRIME OR INCIDENT

On 04-28-15 at 2338 hours I was conducting patrol when I observed a black Ford, bearing WA registration 824WSH, traveling southbound on STH 32 at CTH E. I observed the vehicle to have a defective driver's side headlamp. I stopped the vehicle for the violation. I contacted the operator and passenger of the vehicle. The operator, Obadiah Bennett Jr. was taken into custody for two outstanding warrants and issued traffic citations/warnings. The passenger, Gregory Bennett Jr. was taken into custody for possession of a concealed weapon. The vehicle was removed by a family member at Gregory's request.

On 04-28-15 at 2338 hours I, Deputy J. Zarletti #239, was conducting patrol when I observed a black Ford, bearing WA registration 824WSH, traveling southbound on STH 32 at CTH E. I observed the Ford's driver's side headlamp to be defective. I observed the Ford continue southbound and it appeared as if it was checking taverns in the area. The operator of the Ford indicated turns, using a directional, into the Somers House Tavern and the Upper Deck Tavern. The operator never made turns into the taverns and deactivated the directional shortly after passing the taverns. The Ford then turned into the Northside Superette (1810 - Sheridan Rd.) which was closed at the time. Based on observing the defective headlamp and the suspicious operation of the vehicle, along with pulling into the lot of a closed business, I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle.

As I approached the vehicle, I observed both the operator and front occupant immediately raise their hands in the air. I made passenger side contact at the vehicle and instructed the front seat passenger, later identified by WA picture driver's license as Gregory Bennett Jr., to roll down the window to speak with me. Gregory complied. I also contacted the operator through the open passenger window. I identified the operator of the vehicle by his WI picture driver's license as Obadiah Bennett Jr. I began speaking with the subjects as to the headlamp violation and the suspiciousness of the vehicle operation.

Gregory began answering questions I posed. Gregory advised that the Ford belonged to him and that his nephew, Obadiah, was operating the vehicle as a designated driver. I asked Gregory why he needed a designated driver. Gregory advised that he had consumed alcohol. Gregory did not appear intoxicated. I observed no signs of impairment other than the odor of intoxicants on his breath. Gregory advised he did not believe himself to be intoxicated, but had consumed alcohol and did not want to risk operating the vehicle intoxicated. While speaking with Gregory about the headlamp, I also requested proof of insurance for the vehicle.

Gregory advised that he believed his insurance information was in the glove box. I had Gregory check in the glove box for the documents. While Gregory was checking the glove box, I observed several loose rounds of ammunition. The rounds appeared to be 9mm caliber based on previous training and experience. I asked Gregory if he possessed any weapons in the vehicle. Gregory initially denied having a weapon in the vehicle. When I advised Gregory of my observation of the ammunition, Gregory changed the information he provided. Gregory advised that he possessed a High Point 9mm handgun in the vehicle. Gregory advised that he had placed the weapon between the center console and the driver's seat prior to allowing Obadiah to operate the vehicle and had not moved it after Obadiah had taken control of the vehicle. Gregory was not able to locate the insurance information in the glove box. Gregory advised that he believed the documents to possibly be in the center console area. I instructed Gregory not to reach for the documents due to the reported area of the handgun being in close proximity to the center console area. I asked

Gregory if I could go into the center console to recover the insurance information. Gregory gave me verbal consent to obtain the documents and conduct a search of his vehicle. Gregory then, without request, began exiting the Ford. When Gregory exited completely, I asked him if he had any weapons on his person. Gregory advised he did not and he gave me verbal consent to conduct a search of his person. I subsequently did so and located no weapons or contraband on his person.

I had Obadiah exit the vehicle and a pat down was conducted of his person. No weapons were located on Obadiah's person. I then checked the center console for the insurance information. I was able to locate an expired Progressive insurance card (exp December of 2014). I asked Gregory if he possessed a current insurance card. Gregory advised that he did not but the vehicle was still currently insured through Progressive. I then recovered the handgun from the area Gregory reported it to be. I was able to determine that the handgun was a High Point 9mm. The gun had a magazine inserted in it. I ejected the magazine and found it to be loaded with 7 (9mm) rounds. I checked the chamber of the gun and found it to be empty. I then conducted a check of the serial number (P1592672) for wants. I notified dispatch of Gregory and Obadiah's information and requested [redacted]

I then began speaking with Gregory pertaining to the concealed gun. Gregory advised that he was originally from [redacted] but had moved to [redacted] Gregory advised that he returned to [redacted] in April of 2014 and has since resided with Obadiah at [redacted] Gregory stated that he receives mail at the residence. Gregory advised that he was discharged from the U.S. Army and had also transferred his primary health care manager through the Veteran's Affairs to the Kenosha Clinic. Gregory advised that this clinic is a branch clinic of the Captain James A. Lovell Federal Healthcare Center out of North Chicago, IL. Gregory advised that he owns a business (NU Empire Music Group, LLC) in the City of Kenosha. Gregory went on to discuss that he plans to announce his candidacy for the District 7 Alderman election for the City of Kenosha. Gregory advised that is why he was checking the taverns in the area. Gregory stated that he was putting together a fundraising event to be held on May 3rd, 2015 at Columbus Park to announce his candidacy for Alderman.

Dispatch then contacted me with information obtained through NCIC pertaining to Obadiah and Gregory. Dispatch advised that Gregory [redacted] Dispatch advised that Gregory [redacted] Dispatch further advised that Obadiah possessed a suspended WI driver's license and had two outstanding warrants through Kenosha County for his arrest. Dispatch stated that Obadiah had one warrant for Operating After Suspension and one warrant for Sale of Alcohol to Minor. I requested dispatch confirm on the warrants. I then began speaking to Obadiah pertaining to his suspended driving status. Obadiah advised that he knew his license was suspended. Obadiah advised that he believed he possibly had a warrant because he did not pay a previous fine. Obadiah advised that he was driving the Ford for Gregory, who he works for.

A short time later, Dispatch confirmed on the warrants for Obadiah's arrest. I then took Obadiah into custody on the outstanding warrants. I placed Obadiah in handcuffs, double locked them, and escorted him to the rear of my patrol vehicle. I conducted a search of his person and located no weapons or contraband. Obadiah was then secured in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

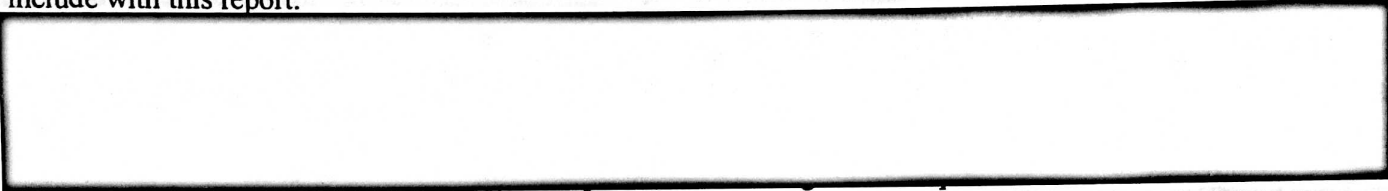
I then contacted Lt. K. Urquhart #166 to obtain additional CCW Permit information. I requested Lt. Urquhart check the reciprocity status of CCW permits through the State of Washington. Lt. Urquhart advised

that WI honors permits issued through the State of Washington. Lt. Urquhart advised that if the subject has established residency in WI, the subject is required to possess a WI CCW permit in addition to any other states issued permits. Lt. Urquhart advised he obtained this information through the WI Department of Justice website. I requested that Lt. Urquhart print a paper copy of the information he provided so I could obtain it to include with this report.



Based on the information Gregory provided, Gregory being in possession of a concealed High Point 9mm handgun, Gregory being a resident of [redacted], and Gregory [redacted] I took Gregory into custody for Carrying a Concealed Weapon. Deputy J. Wilke #281 had responded and was on scene at that time. I requested that Deputy Wilke transport Gregory to the PSB Jail and obtain pictures and fingerprints from Gregory as I was seeking the charge via complaint and summons. Deputy Wilke agreed to do so and subsequently release Gregory after pictures and prints were obtained.

I took possession of the High Point 9mm and retained possession of it either directly or in my locked patrol vehicle until I later logged it into PSB Evidence. I then returned to my patrol vehicle and issued the following citations/charges:

For Gregory, I completed an arrest sheet requesting charges via complaint and summons for one misdemeanor count of Carrying Concealed Weapon {941.23} based on the information I obtained.

Obadiah was issued the following:

ELCI # T081165-0 for Operating After Suspension {343.44(1)(a)} based on Obadiah operating the Ford on STH 32, Obadiah's admission to knowing his license was suspended, and information obtained through WI DOT files which indicated Obadiah's license status as suspended.

ELCI # T081166-1 for Operate a Motor Vehicle without Proof of Insurance {344.62(2)} based on Obadiah operating the Ford on STH 32, no valid proof of insurance was located in the vehicle, and information obtained in which Gregory indicated that the vehicle was insured through Progressive Insurance.

Warning # 0F90C713BC for Unclean/Defective Lights {347.06(3)} based on Obadiah operating the Ford on STH 32, the Ford's driver's side headlamp being defective, and Obadiah not being the registered owner of the vehicle.

I explained citations issued and charges sought to both Obadiah and Gregory. Both had no questions pertaining to the citations/charges. I assisted Gregory with making contact with his mother, Linda Bennett to respond and have the vehicle removed. Once the vehicle's removal was secured, I transported Obadiah to the PSB Jail on the outstanding warrants. Upon arrival, Obadiah was turned over to jail staff without incident. No bond was required on the citations I issued him at that time. I then cleared the jail.

I responded to the PSB Evidence Room. Upon arrival, I logged and secured the High Point handgun into PSB Evidence. The firearm was secured into locker #008.
