

WHEREAS, Detective [REDACTED] has this day complained in writing to the said Court upon oath, showing probable cause that on May 15, 2024, there is now located and concealed in and upon certain premises or evidence, namely the Kenosha County Courthouse—912 56th Street, within the City and County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, and more particularly described as follows:

- Which things were used in the commission of a crime;
- Which things may constitute evidence of a crime, specifically 947.01—Disorderly Conduct of the Wisconsin Statutes; and requests that a search warrant be issued to search said premises for the described property.

SCANNED

The facts tending to establish the grounds for issuing a search warrant are as follows:

1. Your Affiant is a Detective with the Kenosha Department. Affiant has been a duly sworn law enforcement officer employed by the Kenosha Department since January 5th, 2005. Your Affiant was promoted to the rank of Detective within the Detective Bureau in April of 2016. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the Sensitive Crimes Unit for the Kenosha Police Department. Your Affiant has been involved in sexual assault or communications based related investigations involving local, state, and federal violations.
2. The information set forth in the Affidavit is known through your Affiant's investigation and in speaking with persons involved in the incident described. The information set forth is made for the purpose of establishing probable cause to support the accompanying request for a search warrant and contains a summary of the relevant facts. Your Affiant has not included each and every fact known to him concerning the entities, individuals, or events described in this Affidavit.
3. Your Affiant knows, from his training and experience, that offenders often use cellular devices to engage in communications with potential victims. It is known that dialogue is often established between the offender and the victim via message thread, whether that be through text message or via a social media application. It is also known that electronic devices such as cell phones are used to exchange messages, or to send images or video files that may be considered potentially inappropriate, disturbing or even sexual in nature. It is also known that offenders may use electronic devices such as cell phones to store data (images/videos) and make calls/texts to those whom they are possibly preying on. It is also known that offenders will also delete images, message threads or any other material or data from their device(s) to avoid criminal penalty. I also have knowledge that it is possible to conduct a forensic examination on these devices to retrieve data that may have been deleted by the user. The information from these electronic devices may be useful in determining what type of communications are held, and to determine if a crime was committed. Overall, offenders use cellular phones to assist them in criminal activity.
4. Your Affiant has also received additional training in how cellular phones and other mobile devices are often used to facilitate sexual themed crimes. Your Affiant has conducted these types of investigations for over four years.
5. I am currently investigating, pursuant to my official duties, the crimes of 947.01—Disorderly Conduct of the Wisconsin Statutes.
6. On 02/05/24, I Detective [REDACTED] was assigned to conduct follow up regarding a possible sex offense incident that was initially reported at K-Tec West School (5710 32nd Avenue). This public school is located in the City/County of Kenosha, WI. I was initially provided with a CPS report from Kenosha County DCFS. Per this CPS report, an anonymous report was received by the Kenosha Unified School District regarding there being inappropriate messages between a fourteen year old female student (identified in this Affidavit as [REDACTED], with a DOB of ([REDACTED]/09) and an adult male faculty member or teacher. The involved adult male KUSD employee from K-Tec West was positively identified as (Christian J. Enwright M/W 11/23/94). Information was received that [REDACTED] and Christian were "sexting" back and forth with one another.
7. [REDACTED] was initially spoken with by school staff, as she admitted to engaging in communications with her former teacher (Christian Enwright) on social media. [REDACTED] was ultimately allowed to go back to class as she denied there being any wrongdoing via messages between herself or

her teacher. It was also learned that the school confronted Christian on the information that was received, as he also denied there being any inappropriate communications between himself and [REDACTED]. It was later learned that the school did not contact police upon speaking with both subjects, however DCFS was informed by the school of the allegations. The Kenosha PD was made aware of this incident through DCFS approximately four days after the initial information was received.

8. Upon your Affiant's assignment of this case, initial contact was made with [REDACTED]'s family. On 02/07/24, [REDACTED]'s mother responded to the PSB and signed a consent form to have [REDACTED]'s cell phone forensically downloaded. The mother confirmed [REDACTED]'s cell carrier as T-Mobile, and advised she and her husband pay the monthly bill for their daughter's cell service. The following day, [REDACTED]'s cell phone was received by the KPD and later turned over to the KPD Forensic Officers' Unit. [REDACTED]'s cell phone was then downloaded, and the contents were reviewed.
9. Upon review of the cell phone download report, it was evident that [REDACTED] and Christian Enwright communicated at great length via social media platforms, more specifically SnapChat. The SnapChat account or username for Christian Enwright was identified as "enwright23." There were over 100 images of Christian located on [REDACTED]'s photo gallery tab of the download, most of which was him taking a "selfie" or response which showed his face and captions which are evident of him responding to something that [REDACTED] had sent him. There were also short video clips or files observed in the download of [REDACTED] informing someone, possibly a friend of hers which were concerning in nature. In summary, [REDACTED] is observed stating in a video "I'm wearing his favorite shorts, hopefully he notices." [REDACTED] is observed in video "He's gonna do other stuff to me because I like good grades, followed by "That's why I got great grades in science class last year." [REDACTED] is also observed saying "I can't be that freaky because he is 15 years older than me." [REDACTED] is also observed saying "I can remember our hugs are really touchy, and he like grabbed my ass." [REDACTED] is also observed communicating with someone whom is believed to be a friend, as [REDACTED] is referring to whom is believed to be Enwright as her "man." [REDACTED] also makes a video where she states "I hope my man moans my name." [REDACTED] also tells someone that she hopes "she" finds out, as it is believed [REDACTED] is referring to a significant other of the male she is speaking about. [REDACTED] then mentions something to the effect "I hope she hears...Hope there is at least one time when she wakes up at 12 and goes to see what's going on, and she hears him in the basement and he's jerking off and he says my name" followed by how this significant other would catch him and say "Christian, what the fuck." [REDACTED] then mentions "We know he does that to pictures of me, because he has admitted to it." [REDACTED] later references that a female named "Leah" is mentioned while in conversation with whom is believed to be Enwright. It was learned through social media that Enwright has a significant other or possible fiancé named "Leah Thompson." [REDACTED] is also observed telling someone on video "If there is an Irish man, on this bar named Christian, I would ride it." [REDACTED] also takes a video of her stating "And I think he would like me saying I did.....He wants me to be like a little kid that he wants to fuck."
10. On 02/16/24, [REDACTED] participated in a forensic interview at Children's Hospital in Kenosha, WI. [REDACTED] acknowledged having communications on social media with Christian Enwright since June, 2023. [REDACTED] advised Christian initiated the first SnapChat request, however recently they both initiated conversations with one another. [REDACTED] admitted to deleting Christian's SnapChat account from her phone the day this was reported to the school, as she did this because she did not want to get into trouble. [REDACTED] denied there being a "dating relationship" between her and Christian, and stated multiple times she could not remember the content of what they shared or spoke about on social media. [REDACTED] was asked if Christian made mention of him

masturbating to her photographs, and she replied "I don't think he said it like that, explicitly" followed by "He maybe said something kind of like that." [REDACTED] also acknowledged that the conversations or dialogue between her and Christian changed when he told her one day in either November, or December 2023 that "his favorite student came to him in a dream." [REDACTED] advised he was talking about her. [REDACTED] was asked if there was ever any conversations between them which would be deemed sexual in nature, and she replied "I don't know." [REDACTED] also denied there ever being any nude images exchanged at any point in the past between her and Enwright.

11. On 02/16/24, [REDACTED] and her mother were able to make a request to SnapChat, as data history from [REDACTED]'s own profile or account was received. This SnapChat data from [REDACTED]'s account was then provided to the KPD. Upon receiving initial data from [REDACTED]'s SnapChat account, information was learned that Christian Enwright's SnapChat account or username was "enwright23." [REDACTED]'s SnapChat account or username was also identified in the data. Information was learned that Christian and [REDACTED] were "friends" on SnapChat between the dates of (06/13/23) and (02/01/24). In the "snap history" tab in the data download, it was learned that images and videos were exchanged between [REDACTED] and Christian between (06/14/23) and (12/06/24). [REDACTED] is also observed holding a conversation with her "AI friend" on SnapChat, where she is observed asking "What's like grooming?" [REDACTED] is also observed talking about a relationship she is having with an "older male" that is "married." [REDACTED] is also observed asking the "AI friend" which read as "Well what if he does stuff to me that's an action" followed by "like pictures" and "no I mean like pictures of me."
12. [REDACTED]'s mother notified me that [REDACTED] wished to participate in another forensic interview, as she wished to make additional disclosures regarding this case. On 02/29/24, another forensic interview as held with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] again admitted to engaging in communications with Christian Enwright via social media (Snap Chat). [REDACTED] advised her and Christian started messaging back to November, 2023 up until the time this investigation started. [REDACTED] advised that Christian would complement her via message, saying "you look cute" or "you look good." [REDACTED] also mentioned how Christian would tell her things like "I think about you all the time" and "I miss you." [REDACTED] also advised that Christian had told her that he had a dream about them one night, and how what he dreamt about was "inappropriate." [REDACTED] advised her and Christian never texted or engaged in phone to phone communication.
13. On 03/07/24, I received information back from SnapChat, as the requested data from Christian Enwright's account (enwright23) was ready for download. A message thread was observed between Christian and [REDACTED]. The first message between both subjects was learned to be (06/14/23). On (11/11/23) Christian was observed messaging [REDACTED] "I still love you no matter what." The last message between both subjects per the data return showed a date of (12/26/23).
14. Upon review of all information and digital evidence recovered thus far in this investigation, there are concerns that communications have been held for the past several months between an adult male faculty member (Christian Enwright) and a juvenile female [REDACTED] from the same school; communications which could be deemed inappropriate or even sexual in nature. There is evidence of the involved juvenile female [REDACTED] making utterances on video that are concerning of her being a potential victim of sexual abuse or sexual conduct involving the adult male staff member whom has been identified in this case (Christian Enwright).
15. On 03/26/24, an interview was conducted with Christian Enwright. Christian was confronted with the information that has been obtained thus far. Christian admitted to engaging in

communications with his former student [REDACTED] via social media that was identified as (SnapChat). Christian admitted he and [REDACTED] first engaged in small-talk type conversations with each other, and acknowledged that the frequency in which he and [REDACTED] communicated had grown over the past few months. Christian admitted to exchanging still images and short video clips with [REDACTED] over a long period of time on SnapChat. It is known that sharing these images or short videos are common between users or "friends" on this social media platform. Christian was also allowed to review the saved screen shots of himself and his responses to [REDACTED] on SnapChat. Christian indicated that his responses to [REDACTED] were done so in a mentoring type of way, and nothing more. Christian indicated that none of the messages or content that he and [REDACTED] shared on social media were ever sexual or anything that depicted pornography.

16. On 04/23/24, I was instructed by the Kenosha County District Attorney's Office to forward this case and its findings to their office for official review. The recommended criminal charge of Disorderly Conduct-MISD for Christian Enwright was forwarded to the DA's Office. It was later learned that Christian Enwright has been charged with 22 counts of Disorderly Conduct, as this case is now in Branch 6 of the Kenosha County Circuit Court.
17. On 05/10/24, I received a request for follow up from ADA Smathers. ADA Smathers requested that I draft this search warrant to seize Christian Enwright's cell phone at his initial appearance, and then to have this device forensically examined of its contents. A search on CCAP confirmed that the Defendant in this case (Christian Enwright) has been criminally charged with 22 counts of Disorderly Conduct—947.01 and is currently in the Kenosha County Court (#2024CM000647). This search also showed that Christian Enwright has an initial appearance in court for the above mentioned charges on (05/15/24) @ 1300 hours.
18. Your Affiant has knowledge that cellular phones or devices alike will store photographs, text messages, and call history until deleted by the user. Your Affiant has knowledge that it is possible to conduct a forensic examination on a cellular telephone to retrieve data that may have been deleted by the user.
19. Your Affiant is therefore requesting a Search Warrant be authorized for the seizure of the cell phone device that Christian Enwright may possess, and then a forensic examination of the above listed cellular phone or device and that the examination include the search for stored telephone numbers, call logs, text (SMS) messages, multimedia (MMS) messages, e-mails/notes, digital audio and/or video recordings, digital images, settings, stored voice mails, application data, and deleted files.

Based on the foregoing information, your Affiant believes that there are now located in the above-listed premises/property, evidence of a crime: to-wit Section(s) 947.01—Disorderly Conduct of the Wisconsin Statutes.

WHEREFORE, Detective [REDACTED] requests that a search warrant be issued to search the described premises for the specified property or person, and to bring the same, if found, before the Circuit Court for Kenosha County, to be dealt with according to law.
