

STATE OF WISCONSIN - VS - Lorenzo Guyton

The complainant, being first duly sworn on oath, on information and belief, alleges and states that in the County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, the defendant did commit the above described offense(s) and prays that said defendant be dealt with according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

The complainant states that he is an adult citizen and has reviewed the official law enforcement reports prepared under the above mentioned complaint numbers by the above stated officer, whose reports your complainant relies upon as truthful and accurate inasmuch as they were prepared during the course of an official law enforcement investigation. The complainant relies upon the statements of the mentioned witnesses inasmuch as they are citizens and their statements are based on personal knowledge or eyewitness observations; the complainant relies upon the statements of the defendant, if any, inasmuch as they are contrary to the defendant's penal interests and are, therefore, to be believed.

The complainant thereby informs the court that the basis for the above charge(s) is as follows:

On October 30, 2022, Deputy Lozano, of the Racine County Sheriff's Office, was dispatched to Racine Correctional Institution, 2019 Wisconsin Street, Sturtevant, County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, for reports of an attempted escape.

Deputy Lozano arrived and found Lorenzo Guyton, hereinafter the Defendant, lying between the electric and barbed wire outer fences. The Defendant's ankle appeared broken, and was bent at a grotesque angle.

Deputy Lozano spoke with Corrections Officer, MK, who was told by inmate AJ that another inmate was between the fences. Officer MK approached, and found the Defendant laying on the ground. MK asked what was going on, and the Defendant advised that he was recently indicted, so he was trying to escape.

Deputy Lozano viewed surveillance footage from the institution, which showed the Defendant pacing while looking at the exit door. The Defendant then climbs a small fence and crawls towards the outer fence.

Warden Melman advised that he believed the Defendant activated the electric fence when he tried to climb out.

The Defendant is a Repeater based on a Felony conviction for Felony Murder, two counts of Armed Robbery, and one count of Robbery – Use of Force, on July 10, 1992, in Milwaukee County Case No. 1992CF920975. The Defendant was an inmate at RCI, being held on the sentence for these convictions, with a release date of 2042.
