Summary:

On 11-14-2024 at approximately 1100 hours I, Deputy A. Hyatt #318, while working as the School Resource Officer at Westosha Central High School (24617 75th street, Salem WI 53168) I was contacted by Peter Haubrich who advised there was a situation in a Health Class in room 118 during third hour. After speaking to multiple students, speaking with staff, and fielding Speak Up Speak Out anonymous tips, it was determined two students were going back and forth bad mouthing each other. During this argument both students Participation in this incident was unruly. There was minor damage done to property but nothing the school wanted reimbursed. There was no direct threat made toward the school or toward any student. A thorough Threat Assessment was conducted to make sure all students were safe inside the school. This investigation is closed.

Narrative:

On 11-14-2024 at approximately 1100 hours I, Deputy A. Hyatt #318, while working as the School Resource Officer at Westosha Central High School (24617 75th street, Salem WI 53168) I was contacted by Peter Haubrich who advised there was a situation in Health Class in room 118 During third hour.

Peter invited me in on a conversation he was having with a student named [REDACTED] Once I got into the room I had realized I missed the majority of the conversation. Peter was able to fill me in briefly on what they talked about and what was going on after [REDACTED] had headed back to class to obtain her items.

Peter advised the situation was more serious than the minimal information given by [REDACTED]. He learned this information from two Anonymous tips that came in from Speak Up Speak Out advising the following:

First Tip

3rd hour health class a person named [REDACTED] was threatening to kill a student at his house and implied the kids aren't safe in the school.

During third hour health class a boy named [REDACTED] got angry to another kid named [REDACTED] and broke the kid's chromebook. He said he was going to [REDACTED] house to kill him. He then left class and said that the whole class was cooked.

Peter and [REDACTED] came into my office where we discussed the information we had obtained. When questioned [REDACTED] initial stated "I didn't say anything". I then read [REDACTED] the two above tips that came in. Peter advised that we know there was something said based on having multiple students saying otherwise. [REDACTED] eventually ended up telling us that she was just giving people an update. [REDACTED] advised she told one of the girls at her table "your cooked". [REDACTED] advised she meant this as "those kids might get in trouble". [REDACTED] advised "I never said I was going to go to someone's house and kill them".

After speaking with [REDACTED] Peter and I spoke with two individual witnesses regarding this investigation. Both students relayed similar information indication that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] "go back and forth a lot. An example they gave was a conversation as follows: [REDACTED] stated "shut up with your high pitched vocal cords" [REDACTED] responded "shut up you have higher vocal cords then me".

The two student's witnesses described overhearing 3rd hand information from other students in the class. They reported one of the statements they overheard [REDACTED] had allegedly told [REDACTED] to come to his house so he could kill him legally.

The student witnesses described seeing an incident in health class during their third period class. They observed [REDACTED] exchanges words across the classroom and advised [REDACTED] didn't get up right away but instead sat starring at [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] did get up they he walked toward [REDACTED] and grabbed his chromebook and attempted breaking it before throwing it to the ground. (This made a small indentation in the wall that was later photographed). [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED] homework assignment and started ripping it up. [REDACTED] then stated "you're not going to pass it anyways retard". Both student witnesses explained when [REDACTED] came back she grabbed her backpack and told the class "ya'll are cooked". When asked what she meant the students replied "it means you're in trouble".

Following the witness interview Peter and I again met with [REDACTED]. I told [REDACTED] there were allegation she had made a statement come over so I can kill you. In response [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had told her something about (coming to her home) so she [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] "Well don't do that because that would be a home invasion. When I asked [REDACTED] if she thought of that statement "come over to my house so I can kill you legally", as a threat she advised "it does not". [REDACTED] advised that "I wasn't saying I wanted it to happen, but I wouldn't let you break into my house". When asked, [REDACTED] said she did not recall how the conversation initially began.

Based on the concerning statements Peter requested a search of her backpack. [REDACTED] stated "before we do anything can we contact my [REDACTED]". I advised "absolutely". I attempted contacting Alissa via telephone, but she was not able to answer. [REDACTED] asked to use the restroom and I advised if that is that case then we would have to do the search beforehand. [REDACTED] advised "fair enough". Lisa, [REDACTED] was contacted before the search was conducted and stayed on the phone until about half way through the search when Alissa, [REDACTED] called back Alissa stayed on the phone for the remainder of the search.

Alissa came to the school to go over the threat assessment packet with Peter and I. Peter, Alissa, [REDACTED], and myself were present in the office. Over the next hour and a half or so Peter completed the Threat assessment form that is always filled out when these type of comments are made. There are also questions for the [REDACTED] that Alissa was able to answer. The Threat report portion, assessment findings, key observations, family support, stress and trauma, psychotic symptoms, access to firearms, aggressive behavior, bullying, peer relations, and coping section of the form was completed with [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] knowledge of threat portion of the form was completed with Alissa.

At one hour eleven minutes and twenty five seconds my body camera died during this threat assessment interview portion. I grabbed the charging cord right away and was able to turn my body camera on a short time later when it cooled down a little bit. I believe it turned off from overheating.

After finishing the interview with [REDACTED] Peter and I then called in [REDACTED] to speak with him about the situation. [REDACTED] admitted to bantering back and forth with [REDACTED] where he made fun of her and she made of him. [REDACTED] advised when he mentioned her weight, after staring at him for a few moments, [REDACTED] got up and started walking toward him. [REDACTED] stated when he got up [REDACTED] grabbed his laptop, folded it inside out, and threw it down at the wall. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] then ripped up his homework and called him a "retard".

I inspected the laptop involved in this incident and determined it was undamaged. School staff advised they did not want to sign a complaint for the minor damage to the wall.

Both students were counseled regarding appropriate behaviors, actions, and statements as well as respect for their peers. There are no complaints signed in this incident and this investigation is closed.
