Detective Dan Strash, being first duly sworn, on oath says that on September 4, 1995, at the City of Kenosha, in said County, the defendant did:

COUNT ONE: he has violated the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin, specifically, sec. 943.10 (1)(a) and 939.05, Wis. Stats., Party to the Crime of Burglary; in that on September 4, 1995, in the city and county of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, as a person concerned in the commission of the crime, intentionally enter the dwelling of another without the consent of some person lawfully upon the premises with the intent to commit a felony therein. This conduct constitutes a class "C" felony punishable by imprisonment up to 10 years and/or a fine up to \$10,000.00.

COUNT TWO: he has violated the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin, specifically, Section 940.19(3) and 939.05, Wis. Stats., Party to the Crime of Substantial Battery; in that on September 4, 1995, in the city and county of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, as a person concerned in the commission of the crime, unlawfully cause substantial bodily harm to William Pompey by an act done with intent to cause substantial bodily harm to Mr. Pompey. This conduct constitutes a class "D" felony punishable by imprisonment up to 5 years and/or a fine up to \$10,000.00.

On September 4, 1995 at about 7:52 p.m. Kenosha Police Officers Glassman and Gregory were on patrol in the 6700 Block of 14 Avenue when they were flagged down by a group of people requesting a rescue squad. The officers then observed a man, later identified as William Pompey, on the sidewalk in front of 6714 14 Avenue.

Mr. Pompey had a head wound that was bleeding and he was covered with blood. The officers advised dispatch to send a rescue squad. Mr. Pompey was naked except for a shirt wrapped around his waist. The officers accompanied Mr. Pompey into his residence at 6714 14 Avenue and went upstairs so he could obtain clothing.


Mr. Pompey also obtained a towel to attempt to stop the bleeding from his head. As the officers were upstairs in Mr. Pompey's residence, Mario Echols came up to the officers. The officers noted that Mr. Echols was also

injured. Rescue squads arrived and transported both Mr. Pompey and Mr. Echols to Kenosha Memorial Hospital for treatment. The officers had observed two lacerations to the back of Mr. Pompey's head, a lot of swelling under his left eye, and Mr. Pompey was complaining of back and arm injuries. Mr. Echols also had a head injury. At the hospital, Mr. Pompey received 12 staples or metal stitches, to close the laceration to his head.

Mr. Pompey stated to the officers that he had been at his residence that night when he had observed Mario Echols being attacked by several males because Mr. Echols was wearing his hat tilted in a particular direction. Mr. Echols was thrown on the ground and punched and kicked by several men. Among those participating in the assault on Mr. Echols were Janta Parson, Anthony LKU, and Jason Lopez, all members of the Gangster Disciples. Mr. Pompey saw what was happening so he went into his house at 6714 14th Avenue in the city and county of Kenosha in order to get his gym shoes on to help Echols. As he was doing this, Echols got away from the group and came upstairs with Art Pompey. As he was giving Echols a towel to wipe of the blood on his head, one of William Pompey's cousins told him that "the dudes downstairs were talking about coming upstairs to get Art". Just then, the group who was previously beating on Echols came upstairs. They entered the house without his permission. They pushed Mr. Pompey into the kitchen and started beating on him and holding Art Pompey down. This group of people ripped off Mr. Pompey's shirt and shorts and pulled him down the stairs with his head banging on the steps. They pulled Mr. Pompey outside and started beating on him more. One of them started beating on Mr. Pompey with a metal chair. When they had been upstairs, three of the men had pushed Mr. Pompey against a window, causing it to break. After these men had been beating Mr. Pompey outside, some of Mr. Pompey's family came and the group of men ran off. On September 5, 1995 Mr. Pompey looked at several photographs and identified three of the photographs, including one photograph of the defendant, as some of the people who had participated in beating him and entering his residence without his permission.

Your complainant is a Detective with the Kenosha County Police Department and has knowledge of such facts from reviewing the written reports of Officer Glassman, Gregory, Silguero, and Detective's Perri and Kopesky containing the written and oral statements of Williams Pompey, Arthur Pompey and Sandra Steele who are citizen complainant's and eyewitnesses, and which Officer's and Detective's reports are reliable because they personally investigated said offenses and prepared their reports pursuant to their normal duties.

Kenosha County District Attorney Paralegal Sally J. Meyers, being first duly sworn, states that:

Count 1: MISDEMEANOR BATTERY, DOMESTIC ABUSE

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, December 03, 2004, in the City of Kenosha, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, did cause bodily harm to Florine G. Fesby, by an act done with intent to cause bodily harm to that person, without that person's consent and with the knowledge that the person so harmed did not consent, contrary to sec. 940.19(1), 939.51(3)(a), 968.075(1)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 968.075(1)(a) Wis. Stats., because this charge is an act of domestic abuse, costs upon conviction would include the domestic abuse assessment imposed under sec. 973.055(1) Wis. Stats.

Count 2: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, DOMESTIC ABUSE

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, December 03, 2004, in the City of Kenosha, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, while in a private place, did engage in violent, abusive or otherwise disorderly conduct, under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause a disturbance, contrary to sec. 947.01, 939.51(3)(b), 968.075(1)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class B Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 968.075(1)(a) Wis. Stats., because this charge is an act of domestic abuse, costs upon conviction would include the domestic abuse assessment imposed under sec. 973.055(1) Wis. Stats.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

On December 3, 2004 at approximately 7:46 a.m., Officer Herring of the Kenosha Police Department was dispatched to 7620 – 26th Avenue in the City and County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, regarding a battery complaint. Upon arrival, Officer Herring spoke to Florine Fesby. Ms. Fesby stated that she previously lived with the defendant, Jason Lopez, and they have a four-year-old child together. On this date, the defendant was to be at Ms. Fesby’s residence to care for their child while Ms. Fesby went to work, but he did not arrive on time. Ms. Fesby made several calls to the defendant’s cell phone, and when the defendant finally arrived, he and Ms. Fesby argued. Ms. Fesby stated that the defendant became violent and he hit her in the face with his fist three times and he pulled out some hair, both acts causing her pain. Ms. Fesby believed that the defendant was drunk. Ms. Fesby elected to enforce the 72-hour contact prohibition.

Kenosha County Assistant District Attorney Jessica Krejcarek, being first duly sworn, states that:

Count 1: HIT AND RUN - INJURY

The above-named defendant on or about Sunday, May 25, 2014, in the City of Kenosha, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, did operate a motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in personal injury and failed to remain at the scene of the accident until he fulfilled the following requirements, to-wit: give his name, address, and the registration of the vehicle he was operating to the person struck and/or render to any person injured in such accident reasonable assistance, including the carrying, or the making of arrangements for the carrying, of such person to a physician, surgeon or hospital for medical or surgical treatment if it is apparent that such treatment is necessary or if such carrying is requested by the injured person, contrary to sec. 346.67(1), 346.74(5)(b) and 346.74(5)(e) Wis. Stats., a Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or imprisoned for not more than nine (9) months or both.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

Kenosha Sheriff's Department Deputy Carroll reported that on May 25, 2014 at approximately 9:40 a.m. he responded to 6625 16th Avenue, in the City and County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin regarding a hit and run injury accident involving an off duty Kenosha Police Department Detective J. Kenesie.

Upon arrival, Deputy Carroll met with other Kenosha Police Department Officers on scene who reported Detective Kenesie was struck at 67th Street/22nd Avenue and followed the suspect to this location. The suspect was later identified as Jason Lopez, the defendant. Detective Kennedy told Deputy Carroll that he was driving northbound on 22nd Avenue approaching 67th Street, with his wife and three children. Detective Kenesie reported that he was driving at approximately 30 miles an hour approaching the intersection of 67th Street when he saw a maroon full size conversion van traveling eastbound on 67th Street. Detective Kenesie stated he could tell that the van was going to hit the driver side of his vehicle. Detective Kenesie immediately swerved to the right towards 67th Street and then applied the brakes in an attempt to stop but was unable to. The front

passenger side of the van then struck the front driver side area, near the driver side headlight of his Chrysler van. Detective Kenesie did notice that the suspect van had a dent and damage to the rear passenger quarter panel near the passenger side wheel caused by a previous incident. Detective Kenesie stated the van never came to a complete stop. Detective Kenesie was able to get the plate but was unable to see who was driving the van or if it contained any passengers. Detective Kenesie stated he then called Joint Services Dispatch and advised them of the situation. Detective Kenesie stated he followed the van and observed the van quickly accelerate and operate at a very high rate of speed. He estimated the van to be traveling at 80 mph. Detective Kenesie stated the van then slowed down for the stop sign at 67th Street and 18th Avenue but then ran the stop sign at approximately 60mph. The van then turned left onto 16th Avenue where Detective Kenesie lost sight. Detective Kenesie then turned onto 16th Avenue, continued to travel north on 16th Avenue and then observed the van in the driveway of 6625 16th Avenue. Detective Kenesie stated his son Chase K., DOB: 06/16/08 told him he hit the back left side of his head as a result of the accident. Chase K. told Detective Kenesie that it hurt.

Deputy Carroll observed damage to the front driver side of Detective Kenesie's vehicle and collected photos.

Kenosha Police Department Officer Hofmann reported that she responded to 6625 16th Avenue to assist in the above incident. Officer Hofmann reported that many Kenosha Police Department officers were on scene and attempting to locate the suspect. Officer Hofmann reported that there were roofers working on the roof of the house to the north of this address who stated the guy went into the garage and never came out. Officers opened up the garage door and there was a ladder leaned to the rear of the garage up to the rafters. Officers announced themselves and told him to come out. A male voice was telling officers he was coming out and begging that they don't "taze" him. The defendant then came down quietly. The defendant refused to give his name stating "My ID is in my pocket". The defendant was identified by his Wisconsin photo ID as Jason Lopez, the defendant. The defendant stated he wasn't going to tell officers anything.

Robinson reported this to me when I responded to a report of 3 black males chasing Jerome Pompey in the 6700 block of 14 Ave. As it turns out Jerome Pompey is the person Robinson said is the person that shot at him.

Another squad responded and both Robinson and Pompey were brought to the P.S.B. detective bureau. I took a written statement from Robinson while at the P.S.B.

Robinson told me at about noon on 9-5-95 he and Kley Giple were walking in the 6700 block of 14 Ave. Robinson said he saw Jerome, Art, and Quentin Pompey on Jeromes front porch. Jerome Pompey lives at [REDACTED]. Jerome is also William Pompey.

Robinson said Jerome said to him "you started this now I'm gonna finish it" and went into [REDACTED]. Robinson said a few seconds later he saw Jerome come from behind [REDACTED] and point a 12 gauge pump shotgun at him and

fine one shot. Robinson said Jerome Pompy shot from his hip with the gun. Robinson said he ducked and ran and heard one more shot which he believes was aimed at Wley Giple. Giple was running away with Robinson but behind him. Robinson said he heard 3 to 4 more shots after he was about a block away. See Robinson's statement.

Pompy and this report was turned over to the GCU and Det. Perri. Giple has not yet been interviewed.

I was advised by P.O. Glassman that P.O. Karpus had responded to a report of shots fired that occurred about the time Robinson has described. P.O. Karpus did an informational report under case # 95-103355.

However when another faction of the Gangster Disciples saw the subject representing ViceLords they told him to straighten his hat out. However this either was not done fast enough or for someother reason this group began beating the subject. When his friend whom he was talking with came to his aid and attempting to stop and fend off the numerous attackers, the group the focus their attention to him and his family.

At this time the first victim was taken into the house and the others then threaten damage to the house but instead forced their way into the house(apt) and proceeded to beat the Gangster Disciple who had come between them and the Vicelord. This was a deliberate attack on William Jerome Pompey witnessed by Arthur Pompey. The Pompey's are also gangster Discipals, however the group questioned their allegiance to the GD NATION. This was their reason for the vicious assault on William Pompey for standing up his friend a VICELORD.

At this time there is sufficient information that indeed there was gunshots. However as to whom, if not both factions of GD's, fired the weapon(s) is uncertain. Accusations have been made by both sides in this incident. However the possibility of both firing at each other cannot be dismissed. The Complaint filed by Alphonso Robinson and the statement he made and that of the witness he listed do vary greatly. The Statements taken from the Pompey's may far better represent what occurred as a continual retaliation from the night before. At this time both cases are going to be marked as completed investigations. No body can be charged out as to being a shooter in either of the complaints made.

I, FLORINE FOSBY understand that Wisconsin Statute 968.075(5)(a) provides for an automatic, temporary restraining order, which prohibits JASON LOPEZ from having contact with me during the 72 hour period immediately following his/her arrest for an act which constitutes a Domestic Abuse.

I also understand that the Contact Prohibition provides that, during the 72 hours immediately following an arrest for a domestic abuse incident, the arrested person shall avoid the residence of the alleged victim of the domestic abuse incident and, if applicable, any premises temporarily occupied by the alleged victim.

I understand that the arrested person is to avoid contacting or causing any person, other than law enforcement officers and attorneys for the arrested person and alleged victim, to contact the alleged victim, unless there is a signed waiver as prescribed in Wis. Statute 968.075(5)(c).

I understand that JASON LOPEZ may be arrested pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 968.075(5)(a)(1,2) for intentionally violating this provision and required to forfeit not more than \$1000.

I understand that I may waive the temporary Contact Prohibition by requesting a CONTACT PROHIBITION WAIVER FORM from the Kenosha Police Department at this time or at any time during the next 72 hours.

I understand that if I waive the Contact Prohibition, JASON LOPEZ may return to my residence, or another premises temporarily occupied by me, and have contact or cause another to have contact with me.

I understand that if I choose to not waive the Contact Prohibition at this time, I may waive the provision at any time during the next 72 hours by:

1. Going to the Kenosha Police Department, in person;
2. Request a Contact Prohibition Waiver Form;
3. Completely fill out the form and sign it; and
4. Submit the signed form to the Kenosha Police Department.

In addition, I have been notified that the procedure listed below will be followed in regard to the release from custody of the arrested person.

1. They will be taken to the Kenosha County Jail and be processed as an arrested person.
2. Release from custody will be predicated on:
 - a. The arrested person, or someone on their behalf, posting the prescribed bail or bond, if there is one prescribed, or a magistrate prescribes one; and
 - b. The arrested person acknowledging that they were notified of and that they understand and agree to abide by the conditions of the Contact Prohibition and that they were notified and understand the penalty enhancements that will be applied to another incident of domestic abuse within the next 72 hours as prescribed under 939.621, they will be released.
3. When the conditions listed above are met, the person will be released from custody.
4. If the arrested person is cooperative and signs the proper agreements and acknowledgments and posts the proper bond or bail, they will be released.
5. The probable time of release is difficult to determine precisely; but, if the arrested person is cooperative and jail staffing is adequate, it is possible that they could be released in about one (1) hour.

I have read the above information or had it read to me and understand my rights and the procedure for waiving the Contact Prohibition.

I saw a maroon or brown colored full size conversion van traveling east bound on 67th St. I could tell that the driver of the van did not stop at the stop sign on 67th St but I could not tell how fast the van was traveling at that time. I could tell that the van was going to hit the driver side of my vehicle if I continued to drive north. I immediately swerved to the right towards 67th St. I then applied the brakes to my car in an attempt to stop. I was not able to stop. The front passenger side of the full size van struck the front driver side area, near the driver side headlight of my Chrysler van. I did notice that the full size van had a dent and damage to the rear passenger quarter panel, near the passenger side wheel. This damage was caused by a previous incident. I then noticed that the full size van was not going to stop. The van never came to a complete stop after the accident. I was able to see that the full size van had a Wisconsin license plate of 248 KMX. I was not able to see who was driving the van or if any passengers were in the van. I then called the Joint Services Dispatch and advised them of the situation. I followed the full size van because my vehicle was still operable and I knew that no other cars were involved in the accident. The full size van was accelerating quickly and operating at a very high rate of speed. The van was traveling east bound. I would estimate that the Van was traveling 80 miles per hour. I was traveling at a safe speed and I was two to three blocks behind the van. There is a stop sign on 67th St and 18th Ave for vehicles traveling east and west. The Van slowed down for the stop sign but I would estimate that it ran the stop sign at approximately 60 MPH. The full size van turned left onto 16th Ave as I was approaching the stop sign on 18th Ave. I lost sight of the van. I stopped for the stop sign and I continued to follow where I had last seen the Van turn. I turned onto 16th Ave and I did not see the van. I did not believe that the van could have reached the next cross street before I would have seen it. I figured that the van had pulled into a driveway. I continued to travel north on 16th Ave and I observed the van in the driveway of [REDACTED]. I confirmed that the van had the same plate number that I had observed after the accident. I could not see the damage on the van from my vehicle. I was on the phone the entire with dispatch. I told them the location of the full size van. I then went a couple of houses down and I waited for officers to arrive. During that time I spoke with a male black whom told me his name was Leonard Jackson. Mr. Jackson told me that he also witnessed the full size van traveling at a high rate of speed. I asked Mr. Jackson if he would wait for officers to arrive and give a statement. Mr. Jackson told me that he would. Another witness arrived on scene as I was waiting. The witness was a female white. She was driving a green colored car. I did not get the female's name but she also waited for officers to arrive. Officers arrived on scene and made

contact with people inside of [REDACTED] I then walked to the full size van as it was sitting in the driveway. I saw the old damage by the passenger side rear tire. I also observed what appeared to be fresh damage on the front passenger side quarter panel of the car. This is the same location that the offending vehicle struck me. I also felt the hood of the full sized van and I could tell that the hood was warm. I believed that the hood was warm because the engine had been running. Other parts of the full size van that I had touched did not have the same warmth. I am positive that the full size van in the driveway of [REDACTED] was the van that hit me and fled the scene of the accident. It should also be noted that my son, [REDACTED] told me that he hit the back left side of his head as a result of the accident. [REDACTED] said that it hurt. [REDACTED] did not have a bumps or marks. We did not take [REDACTED] to see medical attention at this time.

On Sunday 05/25/14 at about 0920 hrs, I (PO Hofmann #501-full duty uniform and in marked squad #3019) responded to [REDACTED] to assist PO Madsen #464.

PO Madsen was on a Hit and Run where OFF DUTY KPD Detective Kenesie #472 was involved. PO Madsen was at this residence because Det. Kenesie and other witnesses followed the suspect to this address and stated that the suspect ran into the house.

When I arrived on scene, PO Madsen, PO Zielsdorf #340 and Lt. Gemiginani #280 were already on scene. Lt. Gemiginani was securing the rear of the house while the others were searching upstairs. Once we checked the house without locating the suspect, we went into the backyard. There were roofers working on the roof of the house to the north of this address. They stated a guy went into the garage and never came out. We opened up the garage door and there was a ladder leaned to the rear of the garage up to the rafters. We announced ourselves and told him to come out. A male voice was telling us he was coming out and begging that we don't "taze" him. We told him that we wouldn't as long as he showed us his hands and came down quietly. He did. Once he was placed into handcuffs (double locked) by PO Zielsdorf, he became uncooperative. He refused to give us his name stating, "My id is in my pocket". He stated that he wasn't going to tell us anything.

He was id'd by his WI photo ID as Jason Lopez. Jason was asked if he is currently on Probation or Parole, and he said, "Nope, but I will be after this." Jason was searched and PO Zielsdorf placed him in the back of his squad car with the AC running.

I spoke to Det. Kenesie and he said that his family was fine, except his son had bumped his head, but stated that he did not need an ambulance. Det. Kenesie had fresh, moderate-severe damage to the front of his vehicle, (WI plate # 758 JJM(2008 Chrysler Town and Country Red in color) by his driver side headlight cover area. Det. Kenesie stated that the damage to the rear quarter panel of the van (WI plate # 248 KMX-1996 Chevy G10 Sport Van Maroon in color) was already there, and said that the damage from hitting his car was over the front passenger headlight area.

While PO Madsen #464 was speaking to the victims and witnesses, PO Van Wie # 482 was at Safari's Bar Parking lot, 6320 23 Av with another hit and run victim. The owner of this vehicle is the same owner as the vehicle that Jason was driving. That plate number is 901 LTH and is on a 2010 Gray Chevy Traverse. Both vehicle's are owned by Taneeka Lopez.

I cleared 16 Av and I went to speak with PO Van Wie to see if these hit and runs were related. Taneeka's vehicle was parked in the parking lot with the front of her vehicle parked facing n/b towards the fence line. There was a dent with a shoe print on the front passenger door. The heel of the shoe print was higher than the toe of the shoe, indicative that the suspect had his/her back towards Taneeka's vehicle and kicked the door by extending the leg towards their back. The shoe print had a circle off center near the heel and had circular lines going around them. This shoe print appeared to be caused by a Nike Air Force One. The damage on her vehicle was centralized to the rear passenger side taillight/brake light area, but there is damage on the rear quarter panel, just before the tail light area. There were several maroon colored pieces on the ground that are consistence with the running board on the passenger side of Taneeka's van. There a yellow reflector with a chrome piece around it that was left at the scene. This is a piece missing from the front passenger side headlight area of Taneeka's Chevy Van.

I then left this scene to go to the original location of the hit and run involving Det. Kensesie. I went to 67 St and 22 Av to see if there was any evidence or debris from the accident. I had not yet spoken with PO Madsen to find out which direction each vehicle was driving. I noticed a small amount of debris on 67 St about 10-15 ft east of 22 Av. The center of the debris field was just south of the center line of 67 St, and was about 2-3 ft east of the crosswalk. I took photographs of the debris and collected all of the pieces. I appears that Jason was driving e/b on 67 St and didn't even slow down at the stop sign, and that Det. Kenesie was driving n/b on 22 Av. Due to the debris field being east of the intersection, it also appears that Det. Kenesie attempted to swerve to the right in an attempt to miss hitting the other vehicle.

I then went back to 16 Av to take photographs of Jason's shoes. Lt. Gemiginani informed me that Taneeka did not want to sign a complaint against Jason for kicking her car because she didn't want anything to happen to him. I did look at his shoes, and they are Nike Air Force Ones.

I then was informed that KSD Deputy Carroll #226 was going to take over the hit and run investigation involved Det. Kensesie.

Once it was determined that Jason was not going to have an non-traffic criminal charges, his handcuffs were taken off from behind his back, and PO Ziesldorf placed them on in front since he was going to be sitting in the back seat for an extended period of time.
