NARRATIVE

On 08/20/21 at 1955 hours, I, PO Megerle #709, was in full Kenosha PD uniform and operating marked squad 3389 (no audio/video). I was dispatched to 2207 25th Ave Kenosha, WI for a Medical Call. Dispatch advised a subject at the residence is having a [REDACTED] issue. Dispatch also advised that he is not conscious and his eyes are rolling towards the back of his head.

Upon arrival, KFD Med6 and E6 were on scene and performing life saving measures on the subject, Robert A. Lorenzo (M/W [REDACTED]/74) verbal confirmed WI DOT. KFD advised Robert's [REDACTED] and he was not responsive, but had agonal breathing.

I spoke with the caller, Stephanie W. Lorenzo (F/W [REDACTED]/77) verbal confirmed WI DOT, who stated she is Robert's wife. Stephanie stated Robert came home from work around 1530 hours and was acting "strange." She explained that it appeared as if he had symptoms from his [REDACTED]; sweating, slurred speech, out of it. Stephanie stated she gave him some food and he took his [REDACTED], which he told her made him feel better and his symptoms go away.

Stephanie stated that since Robert was feeling better and appeared as if his [REDACTED] was normal, she took their children and went to her mother's, Lynn M. Krok (F/W [REDACTED]/50) verbal confirmed WI DOT, residence, [REDACTED], WI at approximately 1709 hours. Stephanie stated while she was there she texted him, but did not receive a response. Stephanie explained to me that she returned to her residence with the children at approximately 1940 hours and found Robert lying on the couch "snoring." Stephanie stated Robert was not responsive and when she opened his eyes they were rolled back towards his head.

Stephanie advised me that Robert has been a [REDACTED] for about 15 years. She stated that he typically runs high, but it can usually be controlled and he has never reacted like this incident. Robert has no known narcotic issues. I did not observe anything suspicious and it appears as if the incident is medical related.

Robert was transported to the hospital by KFD.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE

On 08/20/21 at 1955 hours, I, PO Megerle #709, was in full Kenosha PD uniform. I originally responded to 2207 25th Ave Kenosha, WI with KFD for a Medical call, involving a patient, Robert A. Lorenzo (M/W [REDACTED]/74) with [REDACTED] issues.

When I responded, I did not observe KFD performing CPR; however, they were giving Robert oxygen. KFD advised that Robert was having major [REDACTED] issues most likely related to his [REDACTED] but was still alive. They also advised that they would be transporting him to St. Catherine's Hospital (9555 76th St Pleasant Prairie, WI) in the condition he was in.

On 08/21/21 at approximately 2133 hours, I, PO Megerle #709 was in full Kenosha PD uniform and operating marked squad 3447 (no audio/video). I followed up with St. Catherine's Hospital via phone. Nurse Brooke Bower advised that Robert was admitted to the hospital and was being seen by her and Dr. Bahrathi Pulla in room #2310. Nurse Brooke advised me that Robert is now in a stable condition; conscious and breathing. She also advised me that Robert's urine test showed a positive result for Cocaine and Benzodiazepines. Robert's current condition is not life threatening.
