I, Patricia J. Hanson, District Attorney in and for Racine County, State of Wisconsin, do hereby inform the court that the defendant did commit within the jurisdiction of Racine County, Wisconsin, the following crime(s):

Count 2: ATTEMPT MISCONDUCT IN PUBLIC OFFICE - EXCESS AUTHORITY

The above-named defendant on or about 11/02/2021, in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, attempted to unlawfully, intentionally, and feloniously, in the officer's or employee's capacity as such officer or employee, does an act which the officer or employee knows is in excess of the officer's or employee's lawful authority or which the officer or employee knows the officer or employee is forbidden by law to do in the officer's or employee's official capacity, contrary to sec. 946.12(2), 939.50(3)(i), 939.32 Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Count 3: ATTEMPT MISCONDUCT IN PUBLIC OFFICE - EXCESS AUTHORITY

The above-named defendant on or about 02/04/2022, in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, attempted to unlawfully, intentionally, and feloniously, in the officer's or employee's capacity as such officer or employee, does an act which the officer or employee knows is in excess of the officer's or employee's lawful authority or which the officer or employee knows the officer or employee is forbidden by law to do in the officer's or employee's official capacity, contrary to sec. 946.12(2), 939.50(3)(i), 939.32 Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Count 4: ATTEMPT MISCONDUCT IN PUBLIC OFFICE - EXCESS AUTHORITY

The above-named defendant on or about 02/03/2022, in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, attempted to unlawfully, intentionally, and feloniously, in the officer's or employee's capacity as such officer or employee, does an act which the officer or employee knows is in excess of the officer's or employee's lawful authority or which the officer or employee knows the officer or employee is forbidden by law to do in the officer's or employee's official capacity, contrary to sec. 946.12(2), 939.50(3)(i), 939.32 Wis.
