## Count 1: MISDEMEANOR BATTERY, DOMESTIC ABUSE ASSESSMENTS

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, April 25, 2020, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, did cause bodily harm to TBK, by an act done with intent to cause bodily harm to that person, without that person's consent, contrary to sec. 940.19(1), 939.51(3)(a), 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., because this charge is an act of domestic abuse, and further, invoking sec. 973.055(1), Wis. Stats., the court shall impose the domestic abuse assessment of \$100 for this offense because this charge is an enumerated crime under sec. 973.055(1)(a)1, Wis. Stats., and the conduct constituting the violation involved an act by the defendant against her or her spouse, against an adult with whom the defendant resides or formerly resided, or against an adult with whom the defendant has created a child.

## Count 2: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, DOMESTIC ABUSE ASSESSMENTS

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, April 25, 2020, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, while in a public or private place, did engage in violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or otherwise disorderly conduct, under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause or provoke a disturbance, contrary to sec. 947.01(1), 939.51(3)(b), 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., a Class B Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., because this charge is an act of domestic abuse, and further, invoking sec. 973.055(1), Wis. Stats., the court shall impose the domestic abuse assessment of \$100 for this offense because this charge is an enumerated crime under sec. 973.055(1)(a)1, Wis. Stats., and the conduct constituting the violation involved an act by the defendant

against her or her spouse, against an adult with whom the defendant resides or formerly resided, or against an adult with whom the defendant has created a child.

The official records and files of the Racine County District Attorney's Office, the Wisconsin Department of Justice and/or Department of Transportation reflect that the defendant has the following record of convictions:

The complainant, being first duly sworn on oath, on information and belief, alleges and states that in the County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, the defendant did commit the above described offenses and prays that said defendant be dealt with according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

The complainant states that (s)he is an adult citizen and has reviewed the official law enforcement reports prepared under the above mentioned complaint numbers by the below stated officer, whose reports your complainant relies upon as truthful and accurate inasmuch as they were prepared during the course of an official law enforcement investigation. The complainant relies upon the statements of the mentioned witnesses inasmuch as they are citizens and their statements are based on personal knowledge or eyewitness observations; the complainant relies upon the statements of the defendant, if any, inasmuch as they are contrary to the defendant's penal interests and are, therefore, to be believed.

The complainant thereby informs the court that the basis for the above charges is as follows:

On 4/25/20, Kenosha County Deputy Eric Olsen responded to the residence of Connie Kmiec, located at 8132-238th Avenue, Village of Salem Lakes, County of Kenosha. Once there, Deputy Olsen had contact with TBM, Connie's spouse, who stated that he had been assaulted by Connie, causing injury and without his consent.

TBK reported that he had come home from work and wanted to speak with his wife about financial issues. Connie began to scream at TBK to stay out of her business and grabbed him by the arm, digging her nails into his left forearm causing an injury and bleeding. She continued screaming at TBK until he was able to leave the house and call police, causing a disturbance at the home.
