The defendant did:

Count 1: PHYSICAL ABUSE OF CHILD

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, did recklessly cause bodily harm to a child [REDACTED] contrary to sec. 948.03(3)(b), 939.50(3)(i) Wis. Stats., a Class I Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than three (3) years and six (6) months, or both.

Count 2: MISDEMEANOR INTIMIDATION OF A VICTIM

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, knowingly and maliciously did attempt to prevent [REDACTED] who has been the victim of a crime, from making a report of the victimization to any peace officer or state, local, or federal law enforcement or prosecuting agency, or to any judge, contrary to sec. 940.44(1), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Count 3: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

STATE OF WISCONSIN - VS - Trenton B Kmiec

Count 4: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 5: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 6: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 7: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 8: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, May 1, 2023, in the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, having been arrested for or charged with a felony and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b), 939.50(3)(h) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

The official records and files of the Racine County District Attorney's Office, the Wisconsin Department of Justice and/or Department of Transportation reflect that the defendant has the following record of convictions:

The complainant, being first duly sworn on oath, on information and belief, alleges and states that in the County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, the defendant did commit the above described offense(s) and prays that said defendant be dealt with according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

The complainant states that he is an adult citizen and has reviewed the official law enforcement reports prepared under the above mentioned complaint numbers by the above stated officer, whose reports your complainant relies upon as truthful and accurate inasmuch as they were prepared during the course of an official law enforcement investigation. The complainant relies upon the statements of the mentioned witnesses inasmuch as they are citizens and their statements are based on personal knowledge or eyewitness observations; the complainant relies upon the statements of the defendant, if any, inasmuch as they are contrary to the defendant's penal interests and are, therefore, to be believed.

The complainant thereby informs the court that the basis for the above charge(s) is as follows:

On May 1, 2023, at 2342 hours, Dep Fromm responded to ██████████ in Salem, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, reference a disorderly conduct. Dispatch advised that the caller was upset and crying and said that she needed to speak with a deputy, but that she did not "want to get anyone in trouble." Dep Fromm arrived at the residence and observed a female standing outside. The female, identified as ██████████, appeared to be upset and was crying. ██████████ asked to get in the squad so that she was not speaking with Dep Fromm in front of the residence. Dep Fromm drove down the street to a location where ██████████ would be more comfortable speaking with the deputy.

██████████ advised that she was in an argument with someone and the person pushed or threw her into something and she hit her head. Dep Fromm observed a "goose egg" on the right side of ██████████ forehead near the temple. ██████████ advised that the incident was scary and not "right anymore," but that she did not want to get anyone in trouble. ██████████ eventually stated that the incident was between her and her boyfriend. GR did not specifically name her boyfriend, but deputies were able to deduce that she was in a dating relationship with Trenton Kmiec (4/4/200██████████). ██████████ said she and her boyfriend (hereinafter referred to as Kmiec) had been dating for approximately five months. She stated that Kmiec found something in her phone and the argument began. ██████████ again talked about the incident and said that when she was thrown it was really fast and she hit her head hard. After being thrown, she said she began to freak out and started asking Kmiec what he was doing and said that she did not deserve that. She complained of pain.

GR said after the incident, Kmiec kept asking her about the text messages on her phone and would scare her by pretending to grab her phone. ██████████ said that at some point she attempted to activate the "SOS" feature on her phone, but Kmiec took the phone and was able to cancel the alert. She stated that Kmiec told her "you're not doing that." She reports begging for her phone and that Kmiec called her a whore and told her that she can lay down and go to sleep or walk home. She reports that he made a statement about hoping she got abducted. ██████████ stated that she laid down because Kmiec still had her phone. She reported trying to get her phone back again without any luck. She said she laid straight down with her hands near her chest because she was scared. Dep Fromm learned that the incident occurred a little over an hour before he was dispatched.

During the conversation, ██████████ was reluctant to provide much information about Kmiec. She provided some identifying information and that he has a "team of lawyers." Based on the information provided by GR and looking at call history, Dep Fromm learned that Kmiec resided at the original call address. Dep Fromm showed ██████████ a known photograph of Kmiec and asked her if that was her boyfriend. ██████████ did not answer but began to cry once again. Dep Fromm noted that ██████████ then sat in silence before asking "what

was going to happen?". Dep From advised that he was going to take her home and then he would talk to Kmiec. [REDACTED] asked if all the deputy was going to do was talk to him.

Dep Fromm took [REDACTED] back to her residence and then responded back to [REDACTED] Ave to speak with Kmiec. Kmiec confirmed that [REDACTED] was at the residence earlier in the evening and they were hanging out. Kmiec stated that he and [REDACTED] got into an argument because [REDACTED] cheated on him, but he said that nothing else happened. He denied touching her and claimed to not know how [REDACTED] got the "goose egg" on her head. Kmiec denied knowing that [REDACTED] was seventeen years old.

On February 21, 2023, Trenton Kmiec appeared in Winnebago County Circuit Court in case number 23CF151. Kmiec was charged with possession of cocaine with intent to deliver and bail jumping. Kmiec was released from custody pursuant to a \$500 cash bond. As conditions of bond, Kmiec was prohibited from committing any new criminal act. The bond remained in full force and effect on 5/1/23. Kmiec violated his bond by engaging in the above described criminal conduct.

On October 19, 2022, Trenton Kmiec appeared in Kenosha County Circuit Court in case number 22CF1386. Kmiec was charged with possessing narcotic drugs. Kmiec was released from custody pursuant to a \$750 signature bond. As conditions of bond, he was not to commit any new criminal act. The bond remained in full force and effect on 5/1/23. Kmiec violated his bond by engaging in the above described conduct.

On October 4, 2022, Trenton Kmiec appeared in Fond du Lac County Circuit Court in case number 22CF591. Kmiec was charged with recklessly endangering safety with a dangerous weapon, fleeing or eluding causing bodily harm or property damage and two other offenses. Kmiec was released from custody pursuant to a \$5,000 signature bond. As conditions of bond, Kmiec was not to commit any new criminal offense. The bond remained in full force and effect on 5/1/23. Kmiec violated his bond by engaging in the above described conduct.
