

or thereafter, and in the course of the violation caused great bodily harm to another person, PP, contrary to sec. 343.44(1)(b) and (2)(ar)3, 939.50(3)(i) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class I Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than three (3) years and six (6) months, or both.

Probable Cause:

Complainant is a law enforcement officer employed by the City of Milwaukee and bases this complaint upon official reports prepared by Officer Lee and on information and belief as follows:

On September 2, 2023 Officer Lee was dispatched to the area of 1350 East Brady Street for a pedestrian that had been struck. Upon arrival, Officer Lee observed PP laying in the roadway, approximately 30 feet away from the crosswalk. PP was in obvious pain and shock. Officer Lee spoke to a witness, CCT. CCT stated that he observed a silver/white SUV driving eastbound on E. Brady Street. CCT observed the SUV make a left hand turn and struck PP. CCT observed the white/silver SUV not stop after the collision and instead just continued driving away from the scene. PP was transported to the hospital for his injuries and treated for a lacerated liver, broken ribs and a left wrist fracture as a result of being struck.

Officers were able to locate video from the crash that showed PP being struck and "drove over" by a white/silver SUV. The license plate on the vehicle was visible in the video to be "ASL-2678." This vehicle lists to a Katherine Corcoran and is a silver Ford Escape. Ms. Corcoran's address was determined to be 3435 North 76th Street. On September 19, 2023 Officer Schnier went to the listed address and located a silver Ford Escape with the license plate "ASL-2678." While looking at the vehicle, 2 subjects came out (1 man, 1 female). The man was identified on scene as the above-defendant and the female was identified as Katherine Corcoran. Officer Schnier asked both of them, who was driving the vehicle on the night of September 2, 2023. The defendant indicated that he had.

The defendant then provided a Mirandized statement to Officer Schnier in which he stated that he was driving the silver Ford Escape the night of September 2, 2023. The defendant admitted being on Brady Street that night and had been at Black Ink Tattoo Shop. The defendant stated no one else drove the silver Ford Escape that night and that he had the keys to the vehicle the whole time. The defendant was shown video surveillance that shows the silver Ford Escape running over PP. The defendant stated he was sorry. The defendant further admitted to knowing he did not have a valid license.

This complaint is further based upon complainant's review of records from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation which complainant has used in the past and found to be accurate and reliable. Those records indicate that the defendant's driving privilege was revoked.
