NARRATIVE

S- Joel P Trudell (05/13/1979)

Summary:

On 06/21/2022 at 8:30 PM, KSD Deputies were assigned to provide security at a Kenosha County Board meeting which was taking place on the third floor of the Kenosha County Admin building. During this meeting, the board of supervisors were listening to citizen comments before proceeding with the rest of the meeting. One citizen later identified as Joel P Trudell was in the middle of his comments but was later asked to step down due to his rude comments towards another patron in the gallery. Joel refused and deputies were asked to remove him from the room. Deputies asked Joel to leave but he refused multiple times. Deputies then place their hands on Joel in order to escort him from the room. After doing so, Joel instantly became resistive and deputies had to direct him to the ground due to his non-compliance. After struggling with Joel on the floor, his hands were able to be secured in handcuffs and he was removed from the room. Joel was taken to the Kenosha County Jail without further incident and booked in on charges of Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Law Enforcement Officers. This incident was captured on KSD body camera. No further action was taken.

Narrative:

On 06/21/2022 at 8:30 PM, I, Deputy M. Duncan #355 along with Deputy J. Wilson #344 were assigned to provide security at a Kenosha County Board meeting which was taking place on the third floor of the Kenosha County Administrative building located at 1010 56th St. At this point in the meeting, citizens were being allowed to make public statements in front of the county board of supervisors. One such gentleman, who was later identified as Joel P Trudell, was given his turn to make his comments heard publicly.

Prior to Joe taking his turn at the podium, he had interrupted other citizen comments and had been warned multiple times by the chairman to remain civil. At one point, after noticing that deputies were looking in his direction after one of his disruptions, he seemed to blow a kiss in our direction in a loud audible fashion. It appeared that he was trying to mock us while we were performing our duties. I took note of his behavior and continued to supervise the rest of the proceedings.

Once Joel took the stand he spoke out against the proposed policy that would allow conceal carry permit holders to bring firearms into county buildings. He also seemed to accuse certain county supervisors of corruption. At one point he was interrupted by another citizen during his speech. This citizen was told to remain silent and he then excused himself from the room. While he was leaving, he accidentally brushed up against Joel, who took offense to this and said something to the effect of, "If I had a conceal carry I'd take that as a threat". The chairmen of the board advised Joel that the comment was uncalled for and Joel protested asking for more time to speak. He was then asked to step down from the podium and told his time for his comments were over.

Joel protested saying it was his turn to speak and refused to step down. His protests became loud verbal shouts and I and Deputy Wilson were asked to remove him from the room by the chairman. I approached Joel's left side and

Deputy Wilson approached his right. Together, we asked Joel multiple times to step down from the podium informing him that it was time to leave. Joel responded by saying, "no sir" repeatedly. He then began to tense up and grabbed hold of the podium with a very tight grip. This grip intensified once I placed my hands on his arm in attempt to remove them so that we could escort Joel out of the room.

He continued shouting, "no sir" and refused to leave the podium despite being warned with arrest. Deputies were then forced to physically push him away from the podium but he then grabbed hold pf of the wooden rail that separated the public from the board of supervisors. His shouts intensified and he was asked to calm down, to which he only responded with, "You calm down". As deputies attempted to remove his hands from the guard rail, Joel shouted, "Get the fuck off of me! What is going on!" at the top of his lungs. I could that his arms were tensed up to the max and that he was using maximum effort to resist our attempts to remove him from the court room.

Due to Joel's active non-compliance and his resistive behaviors towards law enforcement, I decided to perform a decentralization to direct Joel to the ground so that he could be handcuffed. I secured his left arm with mine and placed my right hand behind his back. I then used my bodyweight to direct Joel to the ground while swinging the left side of his body so that he would fall to his stomach. After directing him to the ground, Joel managed to remain on his hands and knees and continued his active resistance. Deputies had to re-secure his arms and force him forward so that he could be directed onto his stomach. He continued to shout, "I'm trying to talk" and "get off of me" despite being told to comply. Once he was flat on the ground, I secured his wrists in two sets of handcuffs.

After securing his wrists in handcuffs, Joel was directed into a seated position and was asked if he required any medical attention. He stated that he did not and ceased all forms of resistance. I and Deputy Wilson escorted Joel out of the room and out into the hallway. I observed that several citizens appeared to be visibly upset by what had just occurred and were recording the event on their cellphones. As we were in the elevator, a middle aged women approached us and expressed her disapproval with the actions law enforcement took. She was asked to leave and did not cause any further issues.

Joel was brought to Deputy Wilson's squad car #364 where is was officially identified via Wisconsin photo driver's license. He was then transported to the Kenosha County Jail located at 912 56th St. Upon our arrival at the Jail, a search incident to arrest was conducted which yielded no weapons or contraband. Joel remained cooperative as we handed over custody to the correctional staff. After submitting an arrest sheet, myself and Deputy Wilson cleared taking no further action. The rest of our shift was spent escorting County Board Supervisors and their families to their vehicles at their request due to what had happened.

For Joel's actions I am requesting the following charges:

- One count of Disorderly Conduct (947.01(1)). This is for Joel knowingly engaging in profane, boisterous and unreasonably loud behavior after being asked to leave the board meeting. His behavior caused a disturbance in the room and was upsetting towards County Board officials as well as fellow citizens attending the

- meeting.
- One Count of Obstructing/Resisting an Officer (946.41(1)). This is for Joel knowingly resisting the attempts of myself and Deputy Wilson while we were acting in a law enforcement official capacity and with lawful authority.

My KSD issued body camera had died prior to this incident occurring since I was working a double shift and had not had the opportunity to charge it prior to this meeting. This incident was captured on Deputy Wilson's body camera and all footage is attached to this case. For more information, please reference Deputy Wilson's supplemental report which is attached to this case.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE

SUSPECT: Trudell, Joel

On June 21, 2022 at approximately 1930 hours I, Deputy J. Wilson #334 was assigned as extra security at the Kenosha County Board meeting which took place at the Kenosha County Administration building (1010 56th st).

The beginning of the meeting began with citizen's comments where citizens mainly spoke of their support or opposition of the amending of 2011 resolution 63. Resolution 63 prohibited the carry of firearms in any building owned, leased or controlled by Kenosha County. The County Board was to have the second reading of the amendment to resolution 63 which would allow citizens whom possess a concealed carry permit to legally carry a firearm in certain buildings owned by Kenosha County.

During the citizens comments a white male, later identified as Joel P. Trudell, was continually interrupting those trying to speak. Joel was warned twice by the Chairman of the County Board, Gabe Nudo, to be silent as others are speaking. Joel eventually got up to speak during the citizens comments where he shared his disgust for the resolution and those who are supporting it. Another white male whom was sitting in the gallery verbally showed his support for the resolution while Joel was speaking.

After being told to remain silent by Chairman Nudo, the male white got up from his seat, walked past Joel, and got in the line to speak during the comments session. As the male walked past Joel he turned and stated, "See if I had a concealed carry I could take that as a threat."

Chairman Nudo called a point of order and informed Joel that his comment was uncalled for. Joel replied with, "Well it's the truth." Chairman Nudo began to instruct Joel that he would have to remain in line otherwise he would be requested to leave the meeting. Joel was continually yelling over Chairman Nudo's instructions stating, "It's my time to talk." Chairman Nudo requested several times for Joel to cooperate and warned him that he would be removed from the meeting, but Joel continued to yell.

Chairman Nudo requested that Deputies removed Joel from the meeting. Deputy Duncan and I approached Joel whom was still at the podium. As I approached Joel that he grab his papers that were at the podium and leave the meeting. Joel was continually saying, "no sir, no sir" to Deputies requests to leave the meeting. Joel continued his passive resistance in not complying with Deputies orders. As Deputy Duncan #355 grabbed Joel's left arm I grabbed Joel's right.

As we grabbed Joel's arm Joel grabbed a hold of the podium in front of him in an attempt to actively resist Deputies efforts to remove him from the meeting. While holding onto Joel's arm I felt the muscles in his biceps and forearm tense up as if he was gripping the podium harder to counteract Deputies efforts to break his grasp. Deputies were able to break Joel's grasp from the podium which then lead him to grab the double swinging doors that lead from the gallery of the room into the main floor where the Kenosha County Board Members sit during the meetings.

While still attempting to get Joel to comply with officers orders he was still shouting that it was his time to talk.

Eventually Deputies were able to break Joel's grasp from the door and decentralize him to the ground. Once Joel was on the ground he curled up into a ball with his hands underneath his body. I once again grabbed Joel's right arm, with numerous attempts and help from other citizens who attended the meeting, Deputy Duncan and I were able to get Joel's hands behind his back and placed in handcuffs which were checked for proper fit and double locked for his safety. Once in handcuffs Joel stopped actively resisting and complies with officers.

Deputies assisted Joel to his feet and asked him if he had been injured, he stated that he had not been injured and did not want to be seen by rescue personal. Joel was escorted down to my KSD issued squad #362 and transported to the jail where he was turned over to Booking staff without any further issues.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE

On June 21, 2022 at approximately 1900 hours, I, Sgt. David Zoerner, was in attendance at the Kenosha County Board meeting with my wife, taking place at the Kenosha County Administration Building. I was off duty and unarmed. I was seated in the second row on the east side of the room. Deputy Wilson and Deputy Duncan were in the room for security.

During citizen's comments, an individual that I know of as, "Joel," that had been disruptive was speaking, giving his own citizens comments. The individual had been yelling at other citizens as they spoke and was yelling at county board supervisors and being disorderly. The individual had been told multiple times that he was out of order by the County Board Chairman Nudo. Eventually, the individual was told he was not going to be allowed to continue. He refused to step away from the lectern. The County Board Chairman Nudo asked the deputies for assistance. Deputies Wilson and Deputy Duncan approached the individual and tried to get the man to comply and direct him out of the room. He was yelling loudly and resisted the deputies by trying to grip the lectern and pulling away from the deputies. At that time the deputies began going hands on with the subject, I thought the Chairman was saying "Wait, hold on a second." The subject continued yelling. It was difficult to hear the Chairman as the crowd was also loud.

At that moment the deputies directed the subject to the ground and began to cuff him. I was having difficulty seeing them on the ground as several people were standing in the aisle. I moved to the center and past a person standing in the aisle. Off duty KPD officer Cochran knelt to the left of the subject, deputies were actively cuffing and KPD Officer Gonzales was near his legs. No one else was posing a threat to the deputies or officers at that time. The room was still very loud. I observed the crowd and saw the cuffs secured. I picked up the subjects eye glasses from the ground partially under his torso. I picked them up to avoid damage or injury.

The subject was sat up and then brought to his feet. He was escorted out of the room toward the elevator. I walked toward the elevator and handed Deputy Duncan the subjects' eyeglasses to take with him to the county jail.

On duty officers began arriving. I spoke with Lt. Gilley #200 and advised what had transpired.

On 06-21-22 I was an attendee at the Kenosha county board meeting 912 56 st 3rd floor city and county of Kenosha around 2030 hrs. I watched during citizen comments an individual later ID by KSD as Joel Trudell get up to the podium and address the county board.

Trudell's tone was angry and he began to go off topic and yell directly at individual supervisors especially county board chairman Nudo. Nudo asked him to calm down which made Trudell louder. Nudo told him his comments were now over but Trudell would not leave the podium. Two KSD deputies approached Trudell at the podium and verbally tried to have him step away. The deputies then grabbed Trudell's arms and escort him from the podium.

Trudell immediately clenched the podium yelling he was not going to "give up his time" and the Deputies had to yank him away. Once away from the podium Trudell pulled away from the deputies and went toward the swinging doors of the main chambers. The deputies had to grab him again and Trudell looked as though he was trying to go through the swinging doors. Trudell would not comply and had to be taken to the ground. Trudell continued to pull away from deputies on the ground. I then assisted by gaining control of Trudell's legs and assisted in hand cuffing him. Trudell was then taken out of the meeting room and down to a squad car. Trudell did not appear injured and I asked him several times if he was ok. See all other report for details.
